February: At the Annual Membership Meeting, General Manager Matthew Pickle presented the State of the Corporation. The 2024 election was canceled, reappointing incumbents John Gray and Anna Ortiz to the Board of Directors.

March: The Board honored the late Earl Burklund for over 55 years of service. They also reviewed the General Manager's annual performance, discussed desalination RFPs, and approved CCN release requests.

April: The board appointed Joseph "Jay" Vaughn, III to a three-year term. The updated bylaws were approved, and the desalination RFP deadline was extended.

May: John Gray became Board President, while Yvonne Gil-Vallejo and Rebecca Richards retained their roles. Updates on cybersecurity and tariff revisions were presented.

June: The board approved the 45 Williamson settlement and its Tariff updates.

August: BGICO was chosen to negotiate the desalination plant contract, and Hydrant Rescue, LLC, was awarded a maintenance contract.

October: Final Tariff updates and the 2024-2025 fiscal budget were approved. The 2025 Annual Membership Meeting was set for February 19, 2025 and Bird Dog Leak Detection was contracted.

November: The Board approved several actions, including NSSA requests, replaced the December board meeting with a holiday luncheon, new impact fees, and pre-approved GM to accept LUEs under 10.

Community Engagement Highlights:

- Sponsored and participated in local events like the Lockhart Chisholm Trail Roundup, City of Creedmoor Oktoberfest, and Mustang Ridges Police Dept. National Night Out.
- Supported Creedmoor Elementary School as a Trunk-or-Treat sponsor and a water conservation presentation with BSEACD and the Colorado River Authority.
- Paraded in the Lockhart Lighted Parade.
