



5 SIMPLE STEPS TO CHECK FOR A LEAK

STEP 1 - Check your water bill

- Look for spikes - is your water use a lot higher this month than it was last month?

STEP 2 - Check your water meter

- Turn off all faucets, showers, and hoses.
- Check your water meter. Your water meter is generally located close to the entrance of your property in a black plastic box.
- If the numbers are rolling you could have a leak.

STEP 3 - Check your toilet

- The most common culprit of non-damaging water leaks is your toilet.
- Put a few drops of food coloring into the tank at the back of your toilet and let it sit for 10 minutes. If color shows up in the bowl, you have a leak.
- Make sure to flush afterward to avoid staining, and consider replacing your old toilet flapper if it is torn or worn.

STEP 4- Call a certified plumber

- Having a professional plumber fix your water leak can save you a lot of money and headaches!
- Ask the plumber to look for any possible leaks around the house and provide you with suggestions on installing low flow faucets and appliances.

STEP 5 - Call us!
