



HOW TO READ YOUR WATER METER

STEP 1 - Locate your water meter

- Your water meter is generally located close to the entrance of your property in a black plastic box.
- Carefully remove the lid by using a tool such as a large screwdriver or pliers.
- Please use caution when opening the plastic boxes as there may be harmful insects or other animals such as snakes, scorpions, or bees in them.
- If there is dirt on the meter use a damp cloth to clean it off.

STEP 2 -Stop use of water on the property

- Make sure all water using appliances (clothes and dish washer) and fixtures (shower heads and faucets), including irrigation systems are shut-off.

STEP 3 -Take a meter reading

- Your meter measures volume in gallons.
- Record the reading on the meter.
- To get a monthly reading record usage from the first day of the month to the last.
- If all water faucets and sprinklers are turned off in your home, your meter should not be rolling numbers. If so, water may be leaking.
