The initiative garnered widespread interest, with CMWSC receiving several proposals from esteemed companies, including BIGICO, Seven Seas, and TSG.

Following thorough deliberation, the board of directors announced their selection, solidifying their dedication to providing reliable desalination water within the next 12-24 months.

In a strategic move highlighting the significance of innovative water solutions, CMWSC has selected BGICO, as its partner for negotiations. If all agreements are reached, they will move forward together to combat water scarcity challenges and secure a consistent water supply for the community.

The contract details the installation of desalination infrastructure using BGICO's expertise in sustainable water treatment, expected to boost water production and strengthen CMWSC's supply resilience.

With the projected completion timeline, CMWSC underscores the urgency with which it aims to secure a stable water source for its residents and future growth.

Through this collaboration, CMWSC not only embraces technological innovation but also takes substantial strides towards realizing long-term water sustainability goals.




