Preparing for the Future

This year marked a major step forward for Creedmoor Maha Water Supply Corporation as we began retiring two of our oldest and most weathered water towers. These structures have served our communities for decades, standing as familiar landmarks across our service area. But with age comes wear, and replacing aging infrastructure is essential to ensuring long-term reliability, safety, and capacity for our growing system. On August 15, 2025, demolition began on the Hwy 1625 Water Tower, one of the oldest towers in our system. Its retirement marked the first stage of a carefully planned upgrade to strengthen our storage and delivery capabilities. Just a few weeks later, on September 9, 2025, crews moved to the Laws Road site, taking down the water tower and the companion standpipe that had supported the community for generations.


These towers played a vital role in meeting water demands for many years. However, advancements in engineering, increased system needs, and the natural aging of the structures made it time for something stronger and more efficient. Clearing the Laws Road site now opens the door for our next chapter, a modern composite water tower designed to enhance performance, improve system resiliency, and support future growth within our service area.

As we move forward, Creedmoor Maha Water Supply Corporation remains committed to responsible planning, infrastructure reinvestment, and preparing our system for the decades ahead. Retiring these old towers is not the end of a story, it is the beginning of a new one, built on progress, reliability, and continued service to our members and communities.

All board meetings begin at 6:00 PM. CMWSC board meetings are open to members!




The **Annual Meeting & Election**
